

Safety Precautions




Image 1-2: Active area

Overview

- (1). Pen tip
- (2). Power indicator
 - a. On, red: Low battery.
 - b. On, green: Battery is charging.
 - c. Off: Battery is fully charged.
- (3). Barrel button 2
- (4). Barrel button 1
- (5). Charger port
- (6). Charger USB cable

NOTES:

Barrel button functions can be customized in the tablet's driver settings.




Image 2-2: Pen case & clips

- (4). Pen stand




Image 2-3: Pen stand

Pen tip replacement

- (1). Twist the pen stand's top cover counter-clockwise to separate it from the pen stand. Insert the stylus tip into the hole in its center. Tilt the stylus slightly so that the tip catches on the edge of the hole, then pull the stylus and pen stand apart to remove the pen tip.
- (2). Take a new pen tip from the inside of the pen stand.
- (3). Push the new pen tip straight into the stylus.




Image 2-4: Pen tip replacement

{ III. Connect the Artist 22E Pro }

1. Connect the Artist 22E Pro to your computer via the included USB cord.
2. Connect the Artist 22E Pro's power cord. Plug the cord into the included adapter, then into a wall outlet.
3. Connect the Artist 22E Pro to your computer via the included HDMI cord.

{ IV. Driver Installation }

Supported operating systems:

Windows 10, 8, and 7
Mac OS X 10.8 or above

NOTES:

- (1). Disable any antivirus or firewall software and close any non-essential background software before beginning the installation. Some software, such as OneDrive and Dropbox, may monopolize important files and prevent a successful installation. On a Windows operated computer, check the system tray on the bottom-right of the screen and close any software unrelated to your computer hardware.
- (2). Uninstall any existing tablet software before attempting to install the Artist 22E Pro driver. Other tablet drivers will conflict with the Artist 22E Pro driver or prevent installation entirely.
- (3). You can download the latest driver version from the XP-Pen website (www.xp-pen.com) and be sure to extract the ".zip" file contents before running ".exe" or ".pkg."

Windows

- (1). Connect the Artist 22E Pro to your computer using the included HDMI/VGA, USB & Power cords. Turn on the tablet.
- (2). Please download the Artist 22E Pro's latest driver from the support section of our website, www.xp-pen.com
- (3). Extra the ".zip" file contents before running ".exe".
- (4). After a successful installation, the driver's icon (2) will appear in your system tray and on your desktop. If the icon is not present, uninstall the driver, reboot, and repeat step 2.
- (5). (Recommended) Open [Control Panel] > [Display], then set Change the size of text, apps, and other items to 100%.




Image 4-1: Display setting

- (6). In [Control Panel] > [Display], change your dual monitor settings to Extend mode/Extend these displays.
- (7). In Extend mode, set your Artist 22E Pro to monitor 2 and choose a resolution of 1920x1080.
- (8). In Duplicate these displays mode, set both of your monitors' resolutions to 1920x1080.




Image 4-2: Extend mode

- (9). Apply and exit.
- (10). Double-click the driver's system tray icon to open your tablet settings, then set your Artist 22E Pro to Monitor 2 under "Current screen." Apply and exit.

Note:

To use Paint Tool Sai (SAI) with the Artist 22E Pro, please open your computer's Display setting and set "Size of text, apps, etc" to 100%.

Mac

- (1). Connect the Artist 22E Pro to your computer using the included HDMI/VGA, USB& Power cords. Turn on the tablet.
- (2). Please download the Artist 22E Pro's latest driver from the support section of our website, www.xp-pen.com
- (3). Extra the ".zip" file contents before running ".pkg".

- (4). If you run into the error message below, please complete the following steps.




Image 4-4: unidentified developer

- b. Click "Open Anyway" button.




Image 4-6: Lock

- c. Input your user name and password, then click "Unlock."




Image 4-7: Password

- (5). Open [System Preferences] > [Display]. In the Display tab, set your resolution to Default for display.




Image 4-8: Display




Image 4-9: Arrangement

- (6). In the Arrangement tab, you may choose to Mirror Displays. With Mirror Displays enabled, both monitors' resolutions should be set to 1920x1080.
 - (6.1). Open [Finder] > [Applications] > [Touch Tablet] > [Pen Tablet Setting].
 - (6.2). In the Monitor tab, set Monitor Mapping to Color LCD.
- (7). With Mirror Displays disabled, set your Artist 22E Pro's resolution to 1920x1080.
 - (7.1). Open [Finder] > [Applications] > [Touch Tablet] > [Pen Tablet Setting].
 - (7.2). In the Monitor tab, set Monitor Mapping to Artist 22E Pro.




Image 4-10: Monitor

{ V. Driver Settings UI }

Notes:

- (a). The Artist 22E Pro's express keys are designed to work with US English keyboards. Keys may not function correctly with the other keyboard languages.
- (b). By default, the Artist 22E Pro express keys are mapped to standard Photoshop keyboard shortcuts. Keys can be customized to function efficiently in other software.




Image 5-1: Keyboard




Image 5-2: UI

1.1. Barrel Button Settings

You may customize the functions of your tablet pen's barrel buttons here. Use the "Function Key" option to program custom keystrokes.




Image 5-3: Pen Functions Setting

Note:

Pen/Eraser Toggle

With the stylus in range of the Artist 22E Pro's working area, press the assigned barrel button to toggle between pen and eraser modes in compatible drawing software. The current mode will briefly be displayed on your monitor.

1.2. Click Sensitivity & Current Pen Pressure

You can adjust pen pressure to "Output" or "Press" sensitivity on here.

Current Pen Pressure shows the current pressure level being exerted on your tablet and can be used to test pen pressure.




Image 5-4: Click Sensitivity & Current Pen Pressure

1.3. Current Screen

The Artist 22E Pro may be configured for use with single or dual monitors. Generally, this should be set to "Monitor1" or "Monitor 2."




Image 5-5: Current Screen

1.4. Mouse Mode

Absolute (Pen) Mode: Standard tablet mode; Each point of the tablet's work area corresponds to an absolute point on your computer display.
 Relative (Mouse) Mode: Mouse mode; The tablet's work area does not correspond to absolute points on your computer display and your pen works as a standard mouse.




Image 5-6: Mouse Mode

1.5. Windows Ink

Windows Ink capability can be toggled on and off here. Enabling this will allow support for Windows Ink and applications that run using Windows Ink.




Image 5-7: Windows Ink

1.6. Calibration

The Calibration tab allows you to set up calibration for your tablet.




Image5-8: Calibration

1.7. Display Setting

Rotate: You may rotate the Artist 22E Pro's display in this tab.

Note:

The Artist 22E Pro cannot adjust "Color temperature" and "User" in the display settings. This can be done through your video card settings."




Image5-9: Display Setting

1.8. Express Keys Setting

In this tab, you may edit the functions of the Artist 22E Pro's shortcut keys. Use the "Definition" option to program custom keystrokes.

Disable express keys: When you enable it, all of the express keys function will be disabled.

Hide Hints: When you enable it, and click any express keys the message will not popup on the bottom of screen.




Image 5-10: Display Setting




Image 5-13: Mac UI

Note:

Pen/Eraser Toggle

With the stylus in range of the Artist 22E Pro's working area, press the assigned barrel button to toggle between pen and eraser modes in compatible drawing software.

In this tab, you may customize the functions of your stylus' barrel buttons, adjust pressure sensitivity, and test your pen pressure.

Pressure No Support function can disable pen pressure when drawing Click "Default Button Setting" to revert to manufacturer settings.




Image 5-14: Pressure Test

1.2. Monitor

The "Monitor" tab allows you to configure your tablet for use with Moniro1 or Monitor2.




Image 5-15: Monitor

1.3. Express Keys

In the Express Keys tab, you may choose your preferred functions for the Artist 22E Pro's shortcut keys. Use the "Reset Customer Defined" option to program custom keystrokes.




Image 5-16: Express keys

1.4. Calibration

The Calibration tab allows you to calibrate your tablet, map your monitor, or rotate your display. To calibrate, click Calibration ... and follow the on-screen instructions.




Image 5-17: Calibration

This tab displays the current version of your driver software.




Image 5-18: About

{ VI. Driver Uninstallment }

Windows

In the Start menu, open [Settings] → [Apps & features]. Find "PenTablet" and click "Uninstall." Follow the on-screen instructions.

Mac

Open [Finder] → [Application] → [Pen Tablet], then click "Uninstall Pen Tablet" and follow the on-screen instructions.




Image 6-1: Mac uninstall

NOTE :

When attempting to reinstall the Artist 22E Pro driver, be sure to reboot your computer after the uninstallment is complete.

{ VII. FAQ }

1. Where can I download the latest Artist 22E Pro driver?

- a. Latest driver releases can be downloaded from our website (www.xp-pen.com).

2. I can't use the stylus to control the cursor.

- a. Please turn on your Artist 22E Pro and make sure you can see the display.
- b. Please install the driver again then find the tablet icon in the system tray or desktop.
- c. Open it then test the pen pressure gauge inside
- d. If you can't test the pen pressure, please uninstall the driver and reboot. Make sure your computer login account has Administrator authority.
- e. The Artist 22E Pro supports plug and play, please test your stylus pens function before reinstalling the driver. If you have control, please disable your antivirus then go to the XP-Pen website to download the latest driver.
- g. When the download is complete, please unzip and extract the contents of the folder to run the .exe or .pkg installation file.
- h. Open the tablet setting again then make sure you can use the pen pressure on it

3. How do I know that the Artist 22E Pro driver installed successfully?

- a. After installing the driver, the Artist 22E Pro's driver icon  should be visible in your system tray on the bottom-right of your screen (Windows OS) and desktop.
Pen input will control the cursor and pressure sensitivity will be functional in the driver.

4. Why can't I use the pen pressure on the drawing software?

- a. Please make sure the drawing software can support pen pressure
- b. Make sure you have the latest driver installed.
- c. Open the tablet setting and make sure you can test the pen pressure in it
- d. Enable the "windows ink" function then click the ok button to exit. Open the drawing software again and test your pen pressure.
- e. Please note our tablets do not come with drawing software.
